A FACULTY DEVELOPMENT SEMINAR IN TEACHING for 2021-2022



Lehman WAC is committed to improving and supporting student writing in courses across the campus. The year-long program will reflect on best practices for using writing to foster anti-racist civic engagement, compassion, and solidarity. How does writing and writing pedagogy support anti-racist practices in our community? WAC participants will revise or develop interdisciplinary solutions around such issues as sustainability, climate justice, language justice, restorative justice, community health, and literacy.

Topics:

- Compassion in the Writing Process
- Scaffolding and Writing as Life-Giving Processes
- Rethinking Grading and Academic Integrity Policies
- Anti-Racist and Restorative Assessments
- Building Trust and Community in the Classroom
- Strategic Planning and Radical Care



Accepted applicants will receive a stipend and commit to:

- Attending a regular seminar on college writing across the curriculum on select Fridays. The tentative session dates and time for 2021-22 are 10am-1pm on October 15, November 19, and December 10 during the fall term and March 4, April 29, and May 13 during the spring semester. The seminar will be co-led by Professors Sophia Hsu, English, and Sarah Soanirina Ohmer, Latin American and Latino Studies & Africana Studies.
- Working with CUNY Graduate Writing Fellows to experiment with anti-racist strategies and curriculum revisions related to writing goals in a class of their choosing.
- Revising or creating an aspect of their teaching with anti-racist strategies.
